HONORING THE FOUNDER...

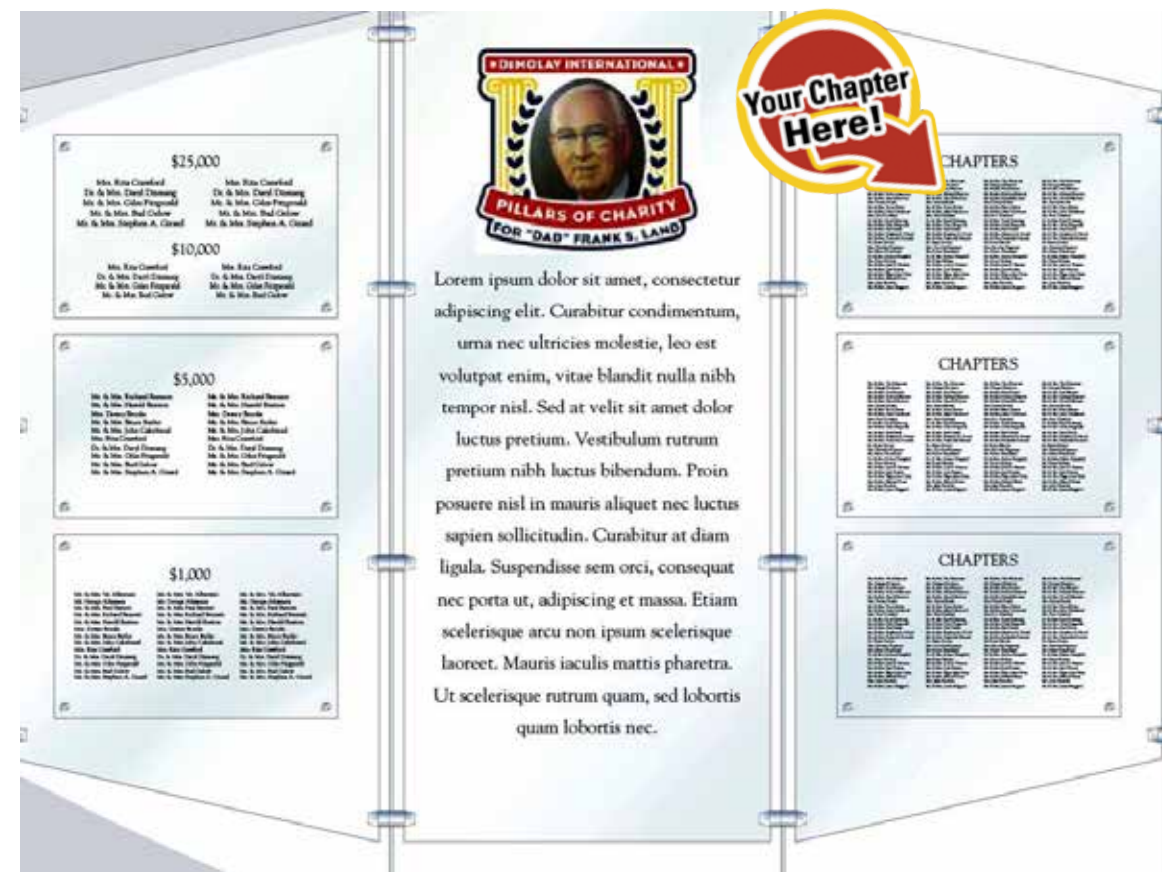
